Special Focus:

Women, youth, war veterans, and vulnerable groups are strongly encouraged to apply. The Municipality is committed to supporting equitable access to opportunities in agriculture and climate-smart innovation.

Who Should Apply:

This opportunity is open to individuals who:

- Are smallholder or emerging farmers currently engaged in farming activities; or
- Are aspiring or prospective farmers with a strong interest in starting farming operations:
- Are residents of Nkangala District and 18 years or older:
- Are committed to adopting climate-resilient farming practices and attending the full training programme.

Requirements:

Applicants must submit the following:

- Completed application form (available at Nkangala District Offices and Website); Certified copy of South African ID (not older than 6 months):
- Proof of residence within Nkangala District Municipality;
- For current farmers: Proof of farming activity (e.g. land access letter, photos, or affidavit);
- For aspiring farmers and war veterans: A brief outline of your farming interest, experience, or vision;
- One-page motivation letter explaining your interest in Climate Smart Agriculture and how the training could benefit your future in farming.
